- Classes also offered for all ages of children.

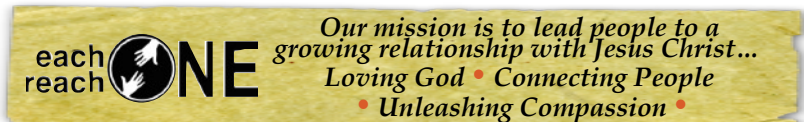
