TO GOD BE THE GLORY!

Several years ago, minister Tom Riley and his wife, Anne, were driving around north Phoenix and noticed all the new housing developments being built. Tom wondered **who would reach all these future inhabitants with the Good News about Jesus?**

God answered that question, and on July 6, 2003 the Rileys and a group of around 40 believers began meeting and worshipping together in Anthem. The very first funds for Canyon Church of Christ came from a child's lemonade stand, and an elderly barber, Paul Lee, who donated his \$90,000 savings. The group met in school gymnasiums, in homes, at the park. They worshipped together, had fun together, cried together, celebrated together, sent out missionaries, learned together, served together, and lived life together.

It's been 15 years since that first meeting, and not much has changed. We have a church building now, but we still meet in homes and at the park, and we still do all those things together: celebrate together, encourage one another, learn together, serve together - to God be the glory.

The Bible tells us the Israelites were instructed to erect standing stones to remind them of God's goodness. **Today, let's remind each other of how God has been faithful to us over the years.** May we continue to seek God and ask Him to guide us, and may we boldly continue to love Him, connect people, unleash compassion in our community, and lead people to Jesus.

COMPASSION FOR NEEDY CHILDREN



This is the last week for our school supplies fundraiser. This outreach effort not only ensures a child is prepared and can go confidently into his first day of school, it also helps build relationships with the family. It's true that, "People don't care how much you know until they know how much you care." We have found a way to get a discount on a bulk purchase of the school supplies and backpacks. So instead of each of us bringing in items, we ask that you make a monetary donation towards this effort. Read on for all the details on how you can help bless the valley's needy children.

1. GOAL - Our goal is to raise **\$3,000** in order to fill **150 backpacks** with school supplies. We currently have currently raised **\$1,247**.

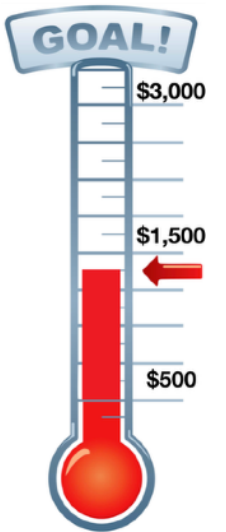
2. DONATE - Canyon's Youth Group has taken the lead on coordinating this service project, so checks should be made out to Canyon Church of Christ with "Youth" in the memo line. Please place checks in the offering plate or hand them to our Youth & Family Minister, Dalton Johnson by **no later this Wednesday**.

3. PACK - We will have a packing party on **July 22**. We'll set up an assembly line and need lots of hands to help fill each backpack with the needed supplies. Watch for more details as this date gets closer.

4. DELIVER - Completed backpacks will be delivered to our partner, Central Phoenix Urban Missions, on **July 29** for distribution to low-income and refugee children in downtown Phoenix.

5. KEEP IT LOCAL - We are also looking to identify children in our immediate neighborhood (Tramonto, Carefree, etc.) that need assistance. **If you are aware of a family that we could bless, please let Dalton Johnson know.**
